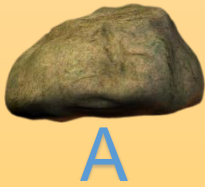
00 4. Close your eyes and listen closely. Circle all the things you hear.

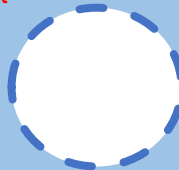
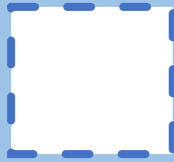
What do you feel? 🖐️

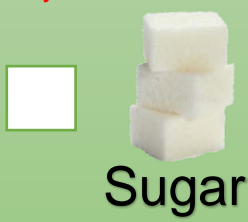
What do you see? 👁️

2. Draw the shapes you see on the pillbox. The students may see all of these shapes depending upon perspective, but the most predominant are squares and rectangles.



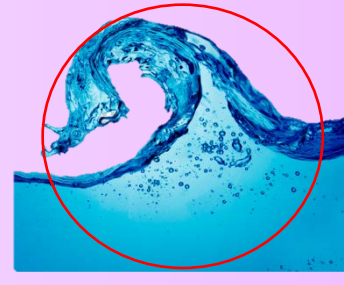
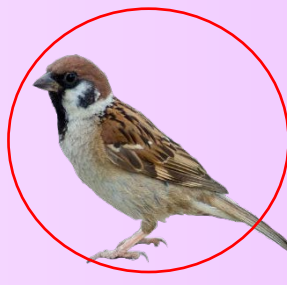
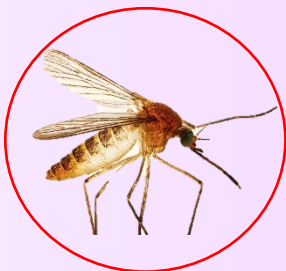
What do you smell? 👃
